

PORT EVERGLADES TARIFF NO. 12

ITEM: ANCHORAGE

EFFECTIVE DATE: OCTOBER 1, 2008

The authorized single anchorage area at Port Everglades is outside of the harbor, north of the Entrance Channel, and east of the outer reef. The anchorage area is designated on N.O.A.A. navigation charts and is under the control of the United States Coast Guard. Vessels desiring to anchor are required to do so in the prescribed anchorage areas so as to avoid damage to the coral reefs. Vessels must contact the Harbormaster via radio prior to anchoring. Refer to code of Federal Regulations, CFR 110.186 for additional requirements.

South of the Entrance Channel, immediately offshore, there is a Government Restricted Area. No anchoring is permitted in this area.

Caution is to be exercised when anchoring a vessel north of the Entrance Channel due to spoil banks and other underwater obstructions. For this reason, the use of a pilot is recommended when anchoring a vessel.
